

REPORTS AND NATIONAL AWARDING FOR THE BEST SCHOOL IMPLEMENTERS (We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty) To: **Regional Directors** Schools Division Superintendents Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned The Department of Education (DepEd) issued DepEd Memorandum No. 410, s. 2009 titled Guidelines on the Establishment of a W.A.T.C.H. School (We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty) to strengthen the values of punctuality and honesty in the Department. This is pursuant to Administrative Order No. 255, and Presidential Proclamation No.1782 titled Declaring the Month of June as W.A.T.C.H. Month. 2 The major goal of the W.A.T.C.H. program is to push forward the recognition of punctuality and honesty as two core values in promoting renewal and development. All W.A.T.C.H. implementers shall include the logos of Project W.A.T.C.H., 3. DepEd, and JCI Senate Philippines in all their activities and marketing collaterals, including backdrops, posters, among other materials. All W.A.T.C.H. advocates are enjoined to adopt another school to become a W.A.T.C.H. implementer. The adoptive school shall guide the adopted school in creating/organizing a W.A.T.C.H. Club and shall assist in the conduct of the adopted school's trainings and activities. The adoptive school and the adopted school shall execute a document mentioning the adoption and shall be signed by the school heads of both schools as the adoptive school and adopted school. A special award shall be given to the top three adoptive schools. An award shall be given to the top three New Implementers. A school, which 5. had joined in the previous selections for the National Search for the Outstanding W.A.T.C.H. Schools, but had not joined any selection after 2016 may qualify for this award. DepEd, together with the Junior Chamber International (JCI) Senate Philippines, has set the schedule of activities for the 2021 W.A.T.C.H. implementation as follows: Schedule Activity Submission of Entries/Entry Form On or before October 25, 2021 Online Submission of Soft Copy (EBook) Pre-judging of Entries (online) October 26-November 20, 2021 Validation . VIDEO DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

The following are the requirements on the creation and submission of the video documentation:

- Must show video of best practices amidst challenges faced during COVID-19 pandemic;
- 2. Must be a high-quality Audio-Visual Presentation in MP4 format;
- Must be uploaded to the official JCI website. In case of inability to upload due to limited accesss/connectivity, it must be saved in a flash drive (use of CDs/DVDs is discouraged); and
- 4. Must not run for more than five (5) minutes.
- Must contain shots within the prescribed timeframe: November 1, 2020 to October 25, 2021.
- 6. Must be submitted and labeled with the following information:
